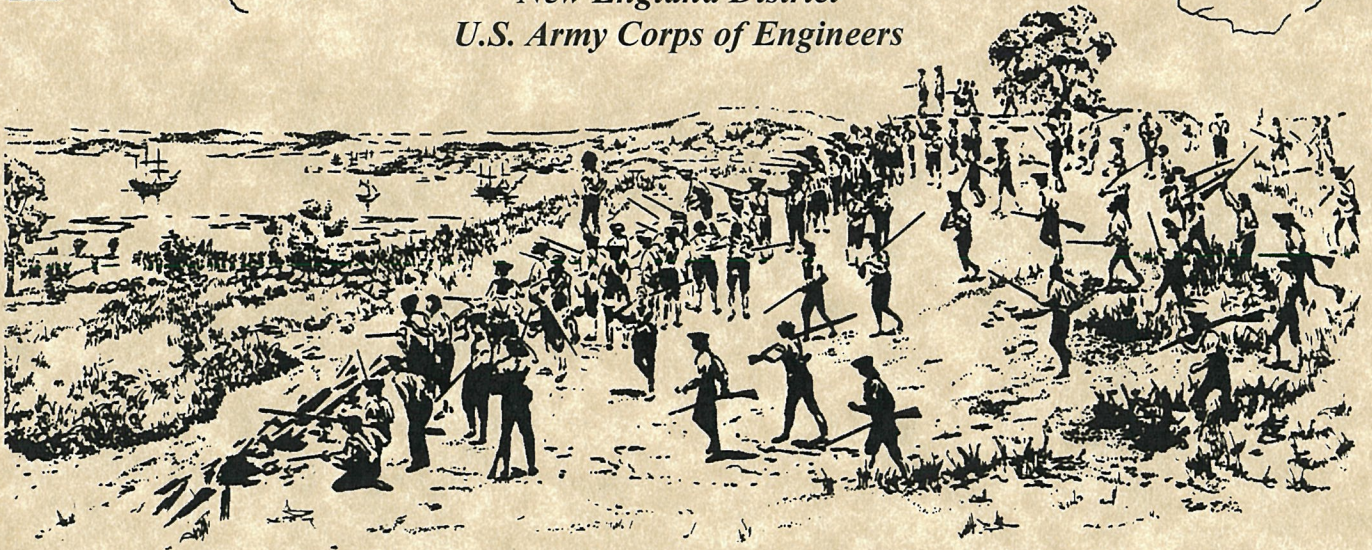

In recognition of Sevenson Environmental Services' Raymark Project Team, led by Mr. Anthony Laurendi, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers New England District commends the work completed by Sevenson that began in June of 2020. The Sevenson team has successfully completed the remediation and restoration of 28 properties within the Town of Stratford Connecticut, including Ferry Creek. The team's professionalism and dedication to the project and surrounding community has helped garner the trust of project stakeholders and the general public. Moreover, Sevenson's efforts contributed in making the community a safer and cleaner place by removing approximately 100,000 cubic yards of contaminated soil from the various properties.



BATTLE OF BUNKER HILL, JUNE 17, 1775

Richard Gridley, a Major General and Chief in the New England Provincial Army, prepared the defenses at Breed's Hill on June 16, 1775, at Charlestown, Massachusetts. General Washington appointed Gridley "chief engineer" of the Continental Army and Chief of Artillery, with the rank of Colonel, making him the first Chief of Engineers.
